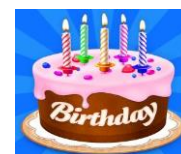
## **NEBA Festival 2019**

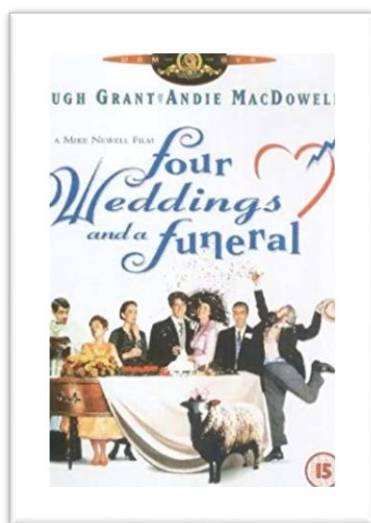
