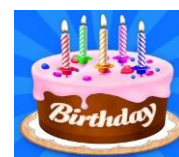


## Pastoral News

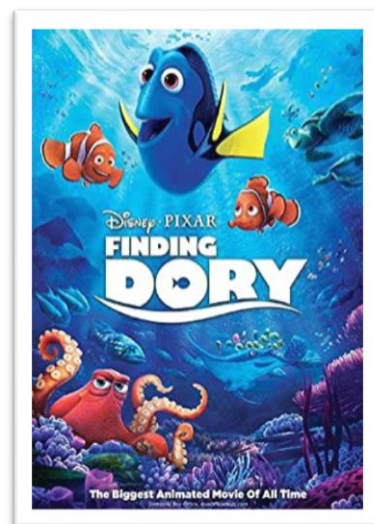

February's family afternoon film is **'Finding Dory.'**

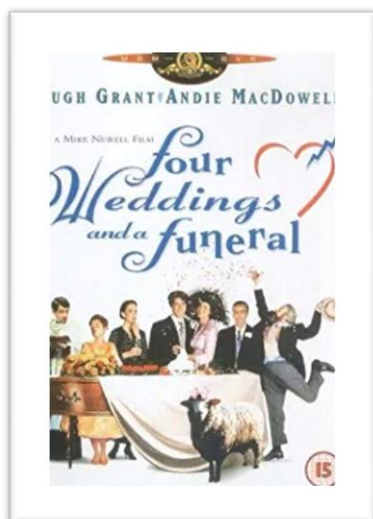
