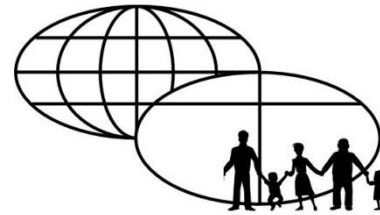
We, of course, pray for her speedy recovery.
