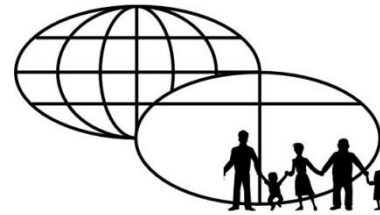
### Sunday services in our Church 2020

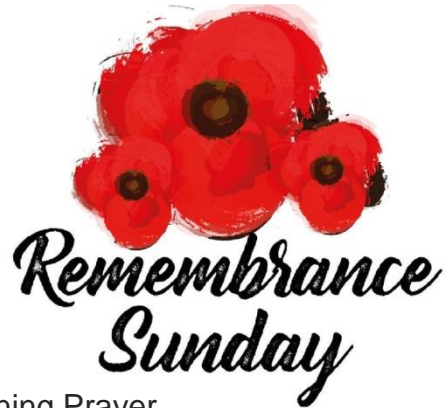
